

No “Home” Policy

What?

If a class can consistently show that they are productive when provided *sufficient* time to work independently in class, then they will only need to submit the work completed by the end of class for full credit – assuming all other assignment criteria are met (see Assignment Submissions & Grading).

How?

sufficient work time + focused practice = no “home” work

Why?

In an effort to support healthy life balance I acknowledge the heavy work load students experience. The purpose of an assignment is to reinforce the lesson taught through practice. The best time for students to do this is shortly after the lesson, which is why I try to allot 15-20 minutes for students to work in class. I believe that if a student works diligently during that time that they can complete enough work to reinforce the lesson for that day. **The ownership is on the student** to determine whether further practice is needed. Students are provided with solutions to assignments so they can check their work for accuracy. Upon request, homework problems can be reviewed at the beginning of class the following day.
